4. T F Most millionaires work 45 – 55 hours per week.
5. T F 80% of millionaires are college graduates. 24% have earned masters or doctoral degrees. Another 14% have earned medical or law degrees. They are well educated.
6. T F 28.6% of millionaires have an American Express Gold card; while 43% have a Sears card.
7. T F Millionaires tend to be married and stay married.
8. T F Only 23% of millionaires drive a current-year car. 9.4% drive a Ford and 8.8% drive a Cadillac.
